## BRIEF HISTORY

The purpose of our club is to have fun while promoting our interests in Corvette ownership, help other fellow Corvette enthusiasts, support local charities, and encourage others to join our enjoyment connected with these legendary cars.

Competition Corvette Association was founded in 1974 as a non-profit organization by a small group of Corvette enthusiasts in the North East Ohio region. We are located primarily in the Lake County area and are a member of the National Council of Corvette Clubs (N.C.C.C.). <a href="www.corvettesnccc.org">www.corvettesnccc.org</a> The N.C.C.C. offers competition series for those members who are interested in the following:

<u>Concours:</u> The Concours was designed to produce a showing of individual refined examples of all automotive marquees.

<u>People's Choice Car Show:</u> This event is a non-judged Corvette show at which spectators can vote for their favorite vehicles – no stress, just fun events!

<u>Rally:</u> An event in which the Corvette is driven on public highways requiring a co-pilot, the navigator, follow a specified route and other fun and often exciting instructions.

<u>Low Speed Autocross</u>: An event in which the Corvette is driven around a course (not on public highways and not wheel to wheel) at speed in such a fashion as to set the quickest time for the course, large isolated parking lots are often used.

<u>High Speed Timed Trials</u>: An event in which the Corvette is driven on one of the road-racing circuits (not wheel to wheel) at speed in such a fashion as to set the quickest time for the circuit. Tracks have included Mid-Ohio Grattan, Pocono, Indianapolis Raceway Park, Daytona, Sebring, Charlotte Motor Speedway, and others.

The N.C.C.C. has established rules for all of the above events and are published in the N.C.C.C. Competition Handbook. <a href="https://www.corvettesnccc.org/NCCCHandbook.html">www.corvettesnccc.org/NCCCHandbook.html</a>

The N.C.C.C. also sponsors a NATIONAL CONVENTION every year where members meet for a week of competition and camaraderie. The annual Convention is usually held in proximity to one of the premiere road-racing facilities in the country.
