The recent vote to suspend EOR sanctioned events for 2020 due to COVID-19 restrict our ability to hold sanctioned events. It was brought to our attention that East Ohio Region standing rules state that the timing equipment and trailer cannot be used for Non-Sanctioned events. Because of this rule and late notice this event is cancelled.
